Executive Vice President, Nuclear Services. GE Hitachi Nuclear Energy



Lance Hall is the Executive Vice President, GE Hitachi Nuclear Energy (GEH) and General Manager, Services and Strategic Development. In this role, Lance has full global P&L responsibility for GEH's nuclear services activities as well as leading key cross-business strategic and business development initiatives.

Lance joined GE on the Knolls Atomic Power Laboratory (KAPL) Field Engineering Program in 1986. From 1989 to 1994, he served as a field representative in the naval nuclear propulsion program. After completing his assignment in the field, Lance held project management roles in Non-destructive Test and Materials Science before leaving KAPL to join GE Power Systems (GEPS) in March of 1997. In his first two assignments at GEPS, he worked as a Project Engineer and a Quality Black Belt in the Energy Products - Commercial Operations group.

In 1999, Lance was promoted to Quality Master Black Belt - Inquiry to Order (ITO) in Energy Products and later that year was promoted to the position of Manager - Business Development for Power System's Global Supply Chain Management organization.

In 2001, Lance was appointed to General Manager, Steam Turbine and Generator Product Lines for the Energy Products business and in 2003, moved to the Energy Services Parts team, where he assumed the role as General Manager, Americas & Asia Parts Operations.

Lance was promoted to General Manager of the Energy Rentals business in 2004, until he assumed the role of General Manager - Services for the Aero-derivative GT business in 2006.

In 2011, Lance re-located to Paris, France to lead the global integration of the Converteam business into GE Energy, a \$3.6B acquisition. He was promoted as General Manager for GE's PowerXpand business, a portfolio of fast power solutions, in September of 2012.

In January 2014, Lance was the SVP for Enrichment Services and the GM, for Strategic Initiatives & Growth. In this role, Lance led the overall strategic direction of Global Laser Enrichment (GLE), a GE, Hitachi, and Toshiba JV. In addition, he was responsible leading strategic marketing and business development activities.

In June 2015, Lance was appointed as the SVP/GM for Nuclear Services and CEO for Global Nuclear Fuel, LLC, the legal entity that manages the Global Nuclear Fuel joint

venture of GE, Hitachi and Toshiba. In this role, Lance led all nuclear services and fuel cycle activities for GEH and GNF.
