Gallagher is responsible for the overall implementation of the license renewal and decommissioning projects for Exelon Generation.

Gallagher has 38 years of experience in the nuclear industry and has held key leadership positions within Exelon Generation. Prior to his current position, Gallagher was Vice President Engineering and Technical Support at the PSEG Salem and Hope Creek stations responsible for performance improvements under the Exelon/PSEG Operating Services Agreement.
